

## Ofsted report 2023

Dear Parents/carers,

We have now received a final copy of our Ofsted report following the inspection that took place on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> January 2023. We are delighted to share with parents and carers that Ofsted have judged Wansdyke Primary School as GOOD in all areas. We are extremely proud of this positive outcome which is a testament to the care and commitment of our staff, the support of our parents and carers, and of course, a celebration of our wonderful children.

The Ofsted report recognised that children at Wansdyke **'are polite, well-mannered and care for one another'** and **'are happy and want to do well'**. The report describes relationships between pupils and staff as **'supportive and caring'**. The inspectors considered the quality of education that we as a school provide, stating that **'the curriculum is ambitious'** and that **'leaders are ambitious for pupils and have high expectations of them all'**.
